

# CITY OF ANGUS REGULAR MEETING January 13, 2026

Mayor Julie Humphries called the meeting to order at 6:55 p.m.

Present for the meeting at roll call were Julie Humphries, Eben Stover, Ken Cook, Becky Henderson, Jerry Newsom and Dylan Tidwell.

Invocation was led by Kim Newsom.

Mayor Humphries stated that she would entertain a motion to approve the minutes of the December 17<sup>th</sup>, 2025 regular meeting. Eben Stover made a motion to approve the minutes. Motion was seconded by Jerry Newsom. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

Mayor Humphries stated that she would entertain a motion to approve the financial report for December 2025. Dylan Tidwell made a motion to approve the financial report for December 2025. Motion was seconded by Becky Henderson. Motion carried by unanimous vote.

## **Angus VFD Report**

Kim Newsom reported that they have now closed out the FAST grant. We have received another grant through the TFS and have ordered a tender truck, and a slip-on unit. We also purchased a 4x4 with the equipment grant we received as well. We currently have three open grants with the TFS, and these are easy grant processes.

End of year numbers, we were dispatched to 283 calls and we responded to 265 of those calls, which puts us at 93%-94% response rate for 2025.

We are planning a work session on January 24<sup>th</sup> to clean up the surplus equipment to list for auction. We have officer elections next month and also received a \$2,800 check from SureFire and are expecting another check from them in February as well.

## **Sewer Report**

Reported that the lift station light has now been repaired and is no longer blinking red. The sewer plant has a line that needs repaired since it is causing our numbers to be off. Mayor Julie Humphries stated to proceed with getting the line repaired.


