No action necessary.

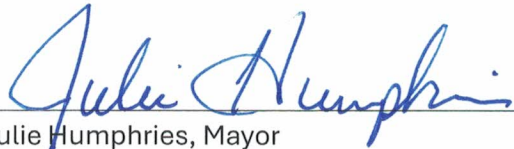
- **ITEM # 5** – Discuss building plans for new fire station, consider city issuing a variance from engineered concrete slab. Take action if necessary.
