

CITY OF ANGUS REGULAR MEETING May 12, 2026

Mayor Julie Humphries called the meeting to order at 7:00 p.m.

Present for the meeting at roll call were Julie Humphries, Eben Stover, Becky Henderson, and Jerry Newsom, Ken Cook, and Trina Kelley.

Invocation was led by Kim Newsom.

Angus VFD Report

Kim Newsom stated first of all thank you to the council for all of your support, we very much appreciate it. The dirt work has now been completed for the new fire station, with the concrete work to begin tomorrow. We recently purchased a storage container and bought shelving for inside the container to store extra fire equipment.

Our recent Texas Forestry Service grant is now closed and has been fully reimbursed. We ordered a skid unit for the back of the UTV to use to run medical calls. We are also ordering PPE for a few of our volunteer members that don't have their own to use.

The governor has put money into the Texas Forestry Service for more grants through HB 2604. We have applied for a \$3000 recruitment grant to use to recruit more people to join the VFD. We can use that money for a billboard for advertising or even use it for mail outs to get the word out. We have been told to reapply for more grants since the money is currently drawing interest and has more money to grant out. We are wanting to upgrade all of our equipment with as many grants as we can apply for and receive. More grants were opened up yesterday on the site and we applied for more.

We have received over 100 calls so far this year for service, with even more expected for Richland since they have a shortage on their VFD volunteers at this time. We are going to clean the smoker up that is currently sitting in the storage building, so that we can do a raffle the smoker and raise money at the same time. We plan on ordering 500 raffle tickets and will sell them at \$10 per ticket for the smoker.

Sewer Report

Kacy Perry reported that the lab results have been high for TSS the last few weeks, so I have sent in a non-compliance form. I will meet the lab guy at the plant in the morning to see where he is pulling his samples from.

Kacy asked the council for a hand washing sink to be put at the sewer plant and will get cost to the council for approval.


ITEM # 5 – Consideration of a substandard structure located at 211 Birdwell. Take action if necessary.
