Dylan Tidwell reported that they have been receiving more calls for fires.

We are waiting on the PPE to come in so that we can close out the grant and get reimbursed. The Chassey build should take 6-9 months and we should be receiving it sometime in November 2026.

The new fire station build is coming along with the concrete slab and plumbing done, and the steel work beginning this week. Once that begins then it should take 30-45 days to complete the building per our builder Cobb. The electrical work will be done after the spray foam is installed. The water meter will have to be moved.

We should be receiving the skid unit for the side by side by the end of July 2026. It will have an 80 gallon water tank installed on it.

Motion to Adjourn

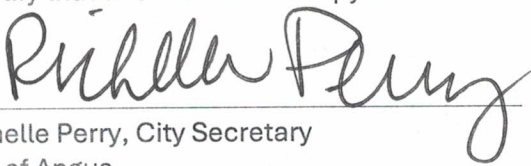
Ken Cook made a motion to adjourn. Motion was seconded by Becky Henderson. Motion carried by unanimous vote.
