We have the Mustang station almost empty, and will be able to cut the electricity soon.

Sewer Report

Kacy Perry reported that the beam across the plant that holds the walk grating needs replaced, and council approved it.

Kacy also said he will be cleaning out the ditch at the auction barn since we have 2 manholes in that area, and will all the rain we got on Monday it was backed up. So he will clean the ditches so the water will flow as normal.
