

ORDINANCE # 163

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A MUNICIPAL COURT FOR THE CITY; PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council hereby establishes a Municipal Court;

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

Section 1

That a Municipal Court is hereby established. That this Municipal Court will be located at the Civic Center, 103 W. Main St., Richland, TX 76681.

Section 2

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and the City of Angus, Code of Ordinances, as amended, except where provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and Code, in which event such conflicting provisions of such ordinances and Code are hereby repealed.


Section 3

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared void, ineffective or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or final decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such ineffectiveness or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation herein of any such void, ineffective or unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 4

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is ordained.

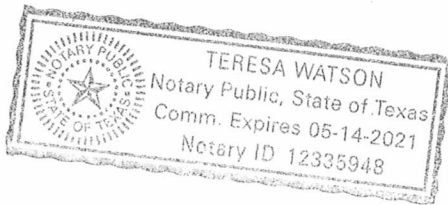

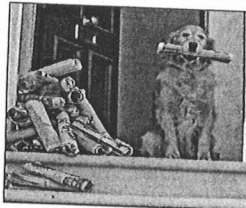
A bid bond in the amount of 5 percent of the bid issued by an acceptable surety shall be submitted with each bid [for those contracts that exceed \$100,000]. A certified check or bank draft payable to the City of Corsicana or negotiable U.S. Government Bonds (as par value) may be submitted in lieu of the Bid Bond.

The project to be constructed will be financed with assistance from the General Land Office (GLO) under the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development Community Development Block Grant - Disaster Recovery (CDBG-DR) program and is subject to all applicable Federal and State laws and regulations.
