ORDINANCE NO. 17

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR PROCEDURES FOR MAKING CLAIMS FOR DAMAGES AGAINST THE TOWN OF ANGUS.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: CLAIMS FOR DAMAGE AGAINST TOWN

Before the Town of Angus, Texas, shall be liable for property damages or for damages for the death or personal injury to any person, the person injured, if living, or his representative if dead, shall give the town secretary notice in writing of such death or injury or property damage duly verified, within thirty (30) days after same has been sustained, stating in such written notice when, where, and how the death or injury or property damage occurred, and the apparent extent of any such injury, the amount of damages sustained, the actual residence of the claimant by street and number at the date the claim is presented, the actual residence of such claimant for six (6) months immediately preceding the occurrence of such damage, death or injury, and the names and addresses of all the witnesses upon whom it is relied to establish the claim for damages. Failure to so notify the City within the time and in the manner specified herein shall exonerate, excuse, and exempt the City from any liability whatsoever.

SECTION 2: CONFLICTING ORDINANCES

All Ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of the conflict.

SECTION 3: EFFECTIVE DATE

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
