SECTION 2: A That said budget attached hereto as Exhibit A, be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted by the city council as the official budget for the city for the fiscal year aforesaid.

the SECTION 3: ar That expenditures during the fiscal year shall be the budget generally made in accordance with the budget approved by this ording the city nance unless otherwise authorized by the city council.

SECTION 4: That the necessity for making and approving a budget for the fiscal year as required by the laws of the State of Texas, creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.

SECTION 5: That the city secretary shall file the approved budget as provided by state law.
