ORDINANCE NO. 66

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, ADDING SECTION 6 OF CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SPECIFICALLY BY ESTABLISHING STOP INTERSECTIONS AT THE INTERSECTIONS OF BUCHANAN BOULEVARD AT FESMIRE ROAD, BUCHANAN BOULEVARD AT BIRDWELL ROAD, AND FESMIRE ROAD AT BIRDWELL ROAD; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY NOT TO EXCEED TWO HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$200.00); AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I

That Section 6 of Chapter 9 of the Code of Ordinances be added to include the following:

**Section 6: Stop Intersections**

It is hereby provided that stop signs shall be erected at the following intersections and such intersections are hereby designated as stop intersections. Every driver of a vehicle shall stop at the stop sign or at the point nearest the intersecting roadway where the driver has a view of approaching traffic on the intersecting roadway before entering the intersection, and shall not proceed until it is safe to do so, yielding to all oncoming traffic. The designated stop intersections are:

- (A) Buchanan Boulevard at Fesmire Road—All traffic on Buchanan Boulevard entering Fesmire Road intersection shall stop and yield to oncoming traffic.
- (B) Buchanan Boulevard at Birdwell Road—All traffic on Buchanan Boulevard entering Birdwell Road intersection shall stop before entering Birdwell Road.
- (C) Fesmire Road at Birdwell Road—All traffic on Fesmire Road entering Birdwell Road intersection shall stop before entering Birdwell Road.

Any person failing to stop at any stop intersection and then proceed only when it is safe to do so shall be guilty of a misdemeanor.

ARTICLE II

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be subject to a fine of not more than two hundred dollars (\$200.00). Furthermore, each and every day any such violation of this ordinance shall continue it shall constitute a separate offense.

### ARTICLE III

That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

### ARTICLE IV

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

### ARTICLE V

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law in such cases provides.

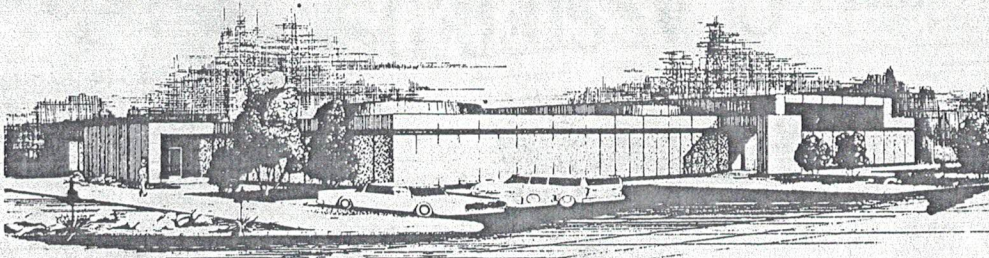

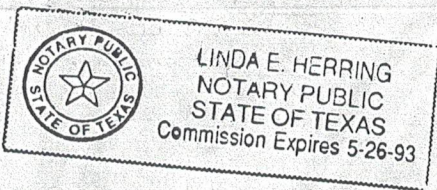
