ORDINANCE NO. 71

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, ADDING SECTION 1-D(6) OF CHAPTER 5 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES SPECIFICALLY BY AMENDING WHO IS CHARGED WITH THE ADMINISTRATION AND RESPONSIBILITY OF MONIES IN THE FIRE DEPARTMENT FUND AND BUDGET; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; REPEALING ANY CONFLICTING ORDINANCES AND CODE PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I

That Section 1-D(6) of Chapter 5 of the Code of Ordinances be amended as follows:

Section 1: FIRE DEPARTMENT

D. GENERAL

(6) All monies collected by the fire department shall go into a fund for the exclusive benefit of the fire department. The fire chief or his designated representative shall present all requests for payments to the city council for approval except for the purchase or payment of single or cumulative items under \$100.00 or when an emergency exists (e.g., required repairs to keep the truck running, replace blown-out tires, etc.). For single or cumulative purchases of items under \$100.00 or when such emergency exists, requests for payments will be submitted directly to the city secretary for payment after approval of the mayor or mayor pro tem. The city secretary shall keep sufficient records to properly document and account for all expenditures. The city secretary is hereby directed to establish a bank account for the fire department in which at least two signatures are required to draw upon the account. Officials authorized to sign checks shall be the mayor, mayor pro tem, and the city secretary.

ARTICLE II

That is is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

ARTICLE III

All ordinances, parts of ordinances, or provisions of the Angus Code of Ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE IV

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law in such cases provides.
