

ORDINANCE NO. 74

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS ADDING SECTION 8 OF CHAPTER 6 TO THE ANGUS CODE OF ORDINANCES SPECIFICALLY PROHIBITING THE USE OF REFUSE CONTAINERS BY NON-RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF ANGUS; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES OR PROVISIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS NOT TO EXCEED TWO THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$2,000.00) FOR EACH OFFENSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I

That Chapter 6, Section 8, of the Code of Ordinances, City of Angus, Texas, is hereby amended to read as follows:

F. USE OF REFUSE CONTAINERS BY NON-RESIDENTS PROHIBITED

It shall be unlawful for any person to place or permit another to place any garbage, trash, or debris in any refuse container provided by the City of Angus for city-wide collection, unless such refuse is from a resident of the City of Angus. Refuse from outside the city limits shall not be placed in any refuse container provided by the City, and doing so, shall be an offense by the person who places such refuse in the container or who permits another person to place such refuse in the container.

ARTICLE II

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00). Furthermore, each and every day any such violation of this ordinance shall continue it shall constitute a separate offense.

ARTICLE III

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not effect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

ARTICLE IV


All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law in such cases provides.


