AN ORDINANCE FOR THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR STAGGERED TWO YEAR TERMS OF OFFICE FOR THE MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS

WHEREAS; the members of the governing body of the town of Angus desire that their terms be staggered, that is that three (3) members of said governing body will have their terms of office expire each election year;

AND WHEREAS; at the present time the terms of each member of the governing body of the town of Angus expire each year;

AND WHEREAS; there is to be a re-election held on April 6, 1974, in which six (6) new members of said governing body will be elected;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED that in the first meeting held by said governing body after the election on April 6, 1974, the said members of said governing body will draw lots for the purpose of determining which three (3) of the newly elected members will serve two (2) year terms and which three (3) of the newly elected members will serve one (1) year terms. After the drawing of said lots, three (3) members of said governing body shall have their terms expire and shall come up for re-election on the first Saturday of April of 1975, and three (3) members of said governing body shall have their terms expire and come up for re-election the first Saturday in April, 1976.
