

CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS  
ORDINANCE NO. 81

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, PROHIBITING THE OBSTRUCTION OF STREETS, SIDEWALKS AND PUBLIC WAYS; PROVIDING A PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

**Section I. Obstructing Streets, Sidewalks and Public Ways Prohibited**

It shall be unlawful for any person to willfully or intentionally obstruct any street, highway, road, alley, sidewalk or other public way within the corporate limits of the City of Angus. Obstructions prohibited herein shall be those caused by the parking of a vehicle or vehicles, the placement of any object, the standing of a person, whether alone or as part of a crowd, or any other act which will in any degree or manner interfere with the uninterrupted use by the public of the whole or any part of any such street, highway, road, alley, sidewalk or other public way.

**Section II. Penalty for Violations**

Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in an amount not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and each and every day's violation shall constitute a separate offense.

**Section III. Severability of Ordinance**

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this Ordinance, or application thereof to any person or circumstances, is held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the Ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Angus hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of the Ordinance despite such invalidity.

**Section IV. Conflicting Provisions**

Any and all Ordinances of the City of Angus heretofore adopted which are in conflict with this Ordinance are hereby expressly repealed insofar as the same are in conflict therewith.

**Section V. Effective Date**


This Ordinance shall take effect immediately, from and after its passage and publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.
